



The Kikuchi Kan Memorial Museum displays personal items related to a notable novelist born and bred in Takamatsu, Kikuchi Kan, who left behind a body of works including "Father Returns" and "Madame Pearl" .





Busshozan/Ichinomiya The Busshozan area of Takamatsu prospered during the Edo period (1603–1868) as the temple-front town of Hounenji Temple, a family temple dedicated to the feudal lord of Takamatsu, Onarikaido Street, which runs through the area, still boasts historical houses and is dotted with renovated cafes and general stores. This secluded area is a unique place where modern times blend with tradition. Ichinomiya is home to many beloved temples and shrines, including Ichinomiyaji Temple, one of the 88 sacred sites in Shikoku. Like Busshozan, the Ichinomiya area can be found along the Kotoden Kotohira Line.

Yashima's historic highlights that capture your imagination include Yashimaji Temple of the Shikoku Pilgrimage, ancient castle ruins, and the historic battlefield of the Genpei War. The sunset from the top of Mt. Yashima is spectacular. Mt.Gokenzan, which lies between the areas of Aji and Mure, is one of Japan's leading stone production areas. The Aji Stone quarried here is called the diamond of granite and is highly valued. You can also visit the filming locations of a very popular movie, "Crying Out Love, in the Center of the World," also known as "Socrates in Love," while in Aji.
